Burra Gallery is celebrating its 20th year in 2016. It is a time for reflection on what they have achieved and where to next as they celebrate connections old and new.

A new connection is here at Gallery M. This year both galleries are participating in a cross promotion of their artists, with the Red House Group currently showing their exhibition in Burra Gallery until 19 June.



20 20 Vision in Gallery M is showcasing the work of regional artists from the Burra area.



Burra Regional Art Gallery is situated in a beautiful building with excellent spaces for showing work from the small and intimate to the huge and confronting, including a small retail shop of affordable high quality works and Artist Cards.

The Gallery provides a venue for artists to exhibit their works in group and solo exhibitions, hosts major touring exhibitions, conducts competitions and invites prominent artists to conduct master classes and workshops.

The building is the historic old Telegraph and Post Office, from which John McDouall Stuart sent his message in Dec 1862, to inform the SA authorities that he had successfully crossed Australia. The S.T. Gill room has four major works by that artist featuring images of Burra in 1847 and 1850.

Mosaic

A mosaic is a picture or pattern produced by arranging together small pieces of coloured tile or glass set in a mortar. Similarly, this exhibition is a juxtaposition of styles and subjects which creates a mosaic of images coexisting within the one system.

Artsparks Collective consists of a group of six artists linked through studies at the Adelaide College of the Arts. The artists meet regularly to support each other, discuss work in progress and to plan for joint exhibitions.



Collective members consist of painters **Bruce Marquis** who paints contemporary subjects and landscapes in oils and acrylic; and **Terry Paterson** who portrays the quiet dignity and daily lives of ordinary folk as they deal with the dust of twenty first century life.

Two other painters are **Ruth Turner** who depicts floral
and figurative works in oil,
and **Mignon Schneider** who
specialises in portraiture with an
emphasis on the human face.

Virginia Paterson is a sculptor who enjoys building and carving the human form, with a special interest in human rights. **Julian Lee** works in a broad range of art disciplines which include painting, drawing and photography often using unconventional methods.



'Mosaic' will provide the viewer with a number of separate ideas, thus creating a multithreaded narrative of combined stories and destinies. In all, a mosaic of tastes, styles and features which produce a range of attractive and stimulating effects.
